Lead Afterschool Instructors work from 2:30 to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday. The salary range is **\$12 to \$15/hour** depending on experience. Responsibilities include:

- Developing and leading student-selected enrichment clubs
- Providing homework help and implementing our online curriculum
- Assisting students to develop positive character traits and life skills
- Being an energetic, engaged, and positive role model at all times

The successful candidate is an energetic self-starter who demonstrates a passion for youth development and work in a non-traditional educational setting. He/she will demonstrate professionalism, the ability to maintain confidentiality, and the diplomacy necessary to successfully interface with parents, school teachers and administrators, and fellow instructors.
